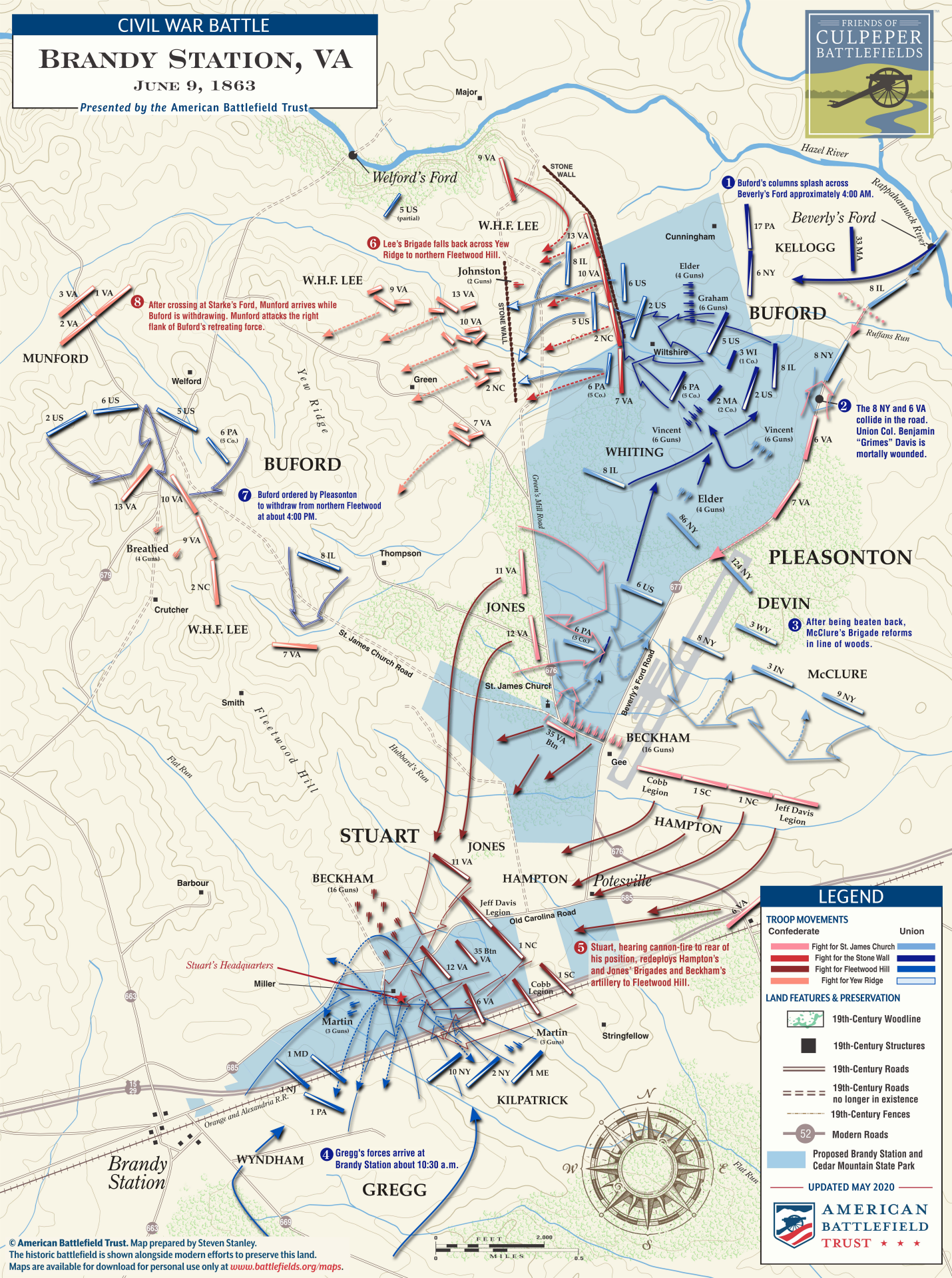
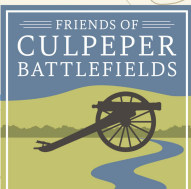


CIVIL WAR BATTLE

BRANDY STATION, VA

JUNE 9, 1863

1 Buford's columns splash across Beverley's Ford approximately 4:00 AM.

2 The 8 NY and 6 VA collide in the road. Union Col. Benjamin "Grimes" Davis is mortally wounded.

3 After being beaten back, McClure's Brigade reforms in line of woods.

4 Gregg's forces arrive at Brandy Station about 10:30 a.m.

5 Stuart, hearing cannon-fire to rear of his position, redeploys Hampton's and Jones' brigades and Beckham's artillery to Fleetwood Hill.

6 Lee's Brigade falls back across Yew Ridge to northern Fleetwood Hill.

7 Buford ordered by Pleasonton to withdraw from northern Fleetwood at about 4:00 PM.

8 After crossing at Starke's Ford, Munford arrives while Buford is withdrawing. Munford attacks the right flank of Buford's retreating force.
